A research poster visually presents your study in a concise, engaging, and informative format, suitable for display during exhibitions, academic conferences, or symposia. It should allow viewers to understand the essence of your research at a glance.

POSTER SIZE AND ORIENTATION**Table 2: Research poster formatting guide**

ELEMENT	REQUIREMENT
Size	A1 (59.4 cm × 84.1 cm) or A0 (84.1 cm × 118.9 cm) - confirm with printers
Orientation	Portrait (vertical) or Landscape (horizontal)
File Format	PDF, PNG, or high-resolution JPEG (min 300 DPI)
File Size Limit	Max 10MB for online submission

POSTER LAYOUT AND CONTENT STRUCTURE

A typical academic poster layout includes the following structured sections:

HEADER SECTION

- Title (bold, large font – 72-100 pt)
- Author(s): Full names and institutional affiliations
- Logo(s): Institutional and funding agency logos (optional)

COLUMN-BASED BODY (2-3 COLUMNS ARE STANDARD)**Table 3: Organize content into clear blocks using headings and visuals**

Section	Description
Introduction/Background	Brief context of your study and rationale.
Objectives/Research Questions	Clear goals of the study.
Methodology	Overview of research design, sampling, and tools. Use diagrams or flowcharts.
Results	Graphs, tables, and visuals with brief explanations.
Discussion	Key insights, interpretations, and comparison with literature.
Conclusion & Recommendations	Summary of findings and practical implications.
References	Use a compact style like APA or IEEE (minimize space).
Acknowledgements	Funding bodies, collaborators, etc. (Optional)

1. Use bold headings and bullet points for easy reading.
2. Ensure high contrast between text and background.
3. Use consistent fonts: e.g., Arial, Calibri, or Helvetica (min 24 pt for body text).
4. Include visuals: graphs, charts, photos, icons, maps (captioned and labeled).
5. Avoid clutter – use whitespace for readability.
6. Include QR Code or Link to full paper or contact details (optional).
